Background:

The Government of Ghana appointed PMI in cooperation with IMDC Consulting Engineers for the Feasibility Study, Design Development, Site Supervision and Project Management of the new urban development at Adjen Kotoku, located approximately 50km inland from Accra, the capital city of Ghana.

The Adjen Kotoku urban development had been implemented initially through the Bulk Infrastructure project, to be then complimented by this Social Infrastructure project.

Social Infrastructure Design:

The social infrastructure was conceptualised by the Client to meet the needs of the community who will populate the development. PMI-IMDC prepared the designs for the following social infrastructure elements as conceptualised:

- Junior Secondary School
- Community Centre
- Clinic
- Police Station
- Fire Station
- Ablution Units
- 6 x 250kl Water Storage Tanks

The designs included details of all the services (electrical, water and sewer) associated with the social infrastructure.

Supervision and Project Management:

PMI have approached the implementation of the Social Infrastructure project from the perspective of proactively engaging with the Design team, Contractor, and Client in order to best achieve delivery.

PMI is responsible on site for Contractor Supervision, Quality Control and Project Management.

The PMI management team has ensured thus far that the project is on track for completion within the required budget and time frame - the works are due for completion in June 2011.
